PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Casting to the Future is a comprehensive fly fishing education and instructional program for girls and boys age 11 to 17. It is sponsored and conducted by the members of Merrymeeting Bay Chapter of Trout Unlimited (MMBTU) with support of the staff and facilities of the Bath YMCA, the Durham, ME Rod and Gun Club, and Canal Side Cabins, Grand Lake Stream, ME.

Basic and essential aspects of fly fishing are taught including equipment selection and preparation, fishing techniques and habitat preservation. There are two Saturday morning sessions inside at the Bath "Y", one Saturday morning on the fishpond in Durham and, for those choosing and eligible for the ultimate experience, a weekend salmon fishing trip to Grand Lake Stream, ME.(GLS)

Travel to GLS is provided by the YMCA, with counselors and fishing partners from the "Y" and MMBTU. Essential fishing equipment, gear, lodging and food are provided by the sponsors. Clothing and all personal items are provided by the participant.

The experience at GLS includes fishing on moving water which requires the participant to follow closely at all times the instructions of assigned adults, but which still holds the potential for serious injury or death.
