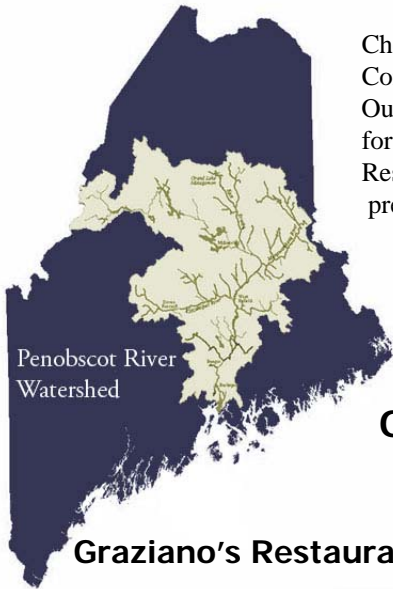

October Fly of the Month:

Hot Spot Para-Ant

Hook: Tiemco #100; Daiichi 1180; Mustad 94840

Size 12 to 24

Thread: 8/0 Uni or 10/0 Gudebrod; or 12/0 Bennechi

Color: Black; Brown; Brown/Black

Body: Black Superfine dubbing

Hot Spot: Flour Pink (or Chartreuse) Z-Ion or Poly Yarn

Hackle: Black or Grizzly Whiting (sized to hook)

Make sure to make your back half larger than your front half; make a *pronounced* gap between the front and back halves.....have your hot spot pink yarn coming out the top of the front half; and "tie off" your hackle using waterproof Super-Glue (Zap-a-Gap).

This is an absolutely *deadly* summer pattern. I've even used it to "ant" a mayfly hatch. NEVER go fishing without at least a half-dozen of these bad boys. Enjoy.
